Many students go straight from Open Water to Advanced Open Water and there is no minimum numbers of dives required. PADI (Junior) Open Water Divers who are at least 12 years old can step up and enroll in an Advanced Open Water Diver course, with some restrictions. After completing the Advanced Course they will be certified up to 21m/70ft, and will automatically upgrade to 30m/100ft when they turn 15.

Everything you need to know about the Advanced Open Water ...

Before completing the PADI Open Water Diver course, your instructor will have you demonstrate basic water skills to be sure you're comfortable in the water, including: Swim 200 metres/yards (or 300 metres/yards in mask, fins and snorkel) without stopping. There is no time limit for this, and you may use any swimming strokes you want.
